### Features of online text

- Most often we only see the photo and the title of the article - it encourages us to read the article and read its content.
- Long expiry date of a text the possibility to find the text even several years later.
- Characterized by dialogue encourages discussion and evaluation.
- Dynamism the ability to edit text in real time, provide additional information.

Header (title): in the form of a declarative sentence, summarizes the message.



Author's name and surname: its place emphasizes that the editors treat the message as

important and take full responsibility for it.

Photo caption: fulfils the informational function.




#### The Three Seas Initiative

The Three Seas Initiative (3SI) is a forum for countries in Central and Eastern Europe that share a common interest in political and economic cooperation, particularly to develop energy and transportation infrastructure in the region. The 3SI held its first summit in Croatia in 2016.

In addition, Germany's foreign policy is ambiguous when it comes to Russia. While Berlin has spearheaded economic and political sanctions against Moscow due to the conflict in Ukraine, it has also defended the <u>controversial Nord Stream 2</u> <u>pipeline project</u>, which would transport Russian natural gas to Germany across the Baltic Sea – thereby bypassing Ukraine as a transit state. German officials insist that Nord Stream 2 is a purely economic project, but history has taught the Baltic countries to be skeptical of pacts between Berlin and Moscow.



#### Threats on the Doorstep

When listening to government officials, academics, business leaders and think tank experts from the Baltic countries, one common theme rapidly emerges: Russia is still widely seen as a threat. This fear is the result of history and geography, because Lithuania, Latvia and Estonia are small, flat and easy to invade. Their position by the Baltic Sea, and their strategic location at the crossroads of the European, Nordic and Russian markets have made these lands an attractive place for invaders, which explains why they have spent so many centuries under foreign rule. Regional powers such as Germany and Sweden invaded the region in the past, but the freshest memories obviously stem from the Soviet occupation after World War II.




